#### **Inmate Escape Report**

(Fiscal Year 2000-2001)

This report provides information for the Fiscal Year (July 2000 - June 2001) of 2000-2001 in reference to attempted escapes, escapes and recaptures from Florida's correctional facilities. This report summarizes the following:

- \* Attempted escapes
- \* Escapes by level, facility type, and facility type by region
- \* Recaptures and recaptures within quarter, by time to recapture, and time to recapture, by facility type
- \* Escape rates by region, and facility type by region
- \* Escapes by facility, facility type, and facility type by region
- \* Escapes by facility type, by month
- \* Escape rates by region by quarter
- \* Escapes FY 1989-1990 to FY 2000-2001
- \* Escape rates per 1,000 inmates for all facilities and for correctional institutions FY 1989-1990 to FY 2000-2001

For purposes of this report attempted escape and escape are defined as follows:

Attempted escape: Inmate is apprehended before completion of the escape act.

Escape: Unauthorized absence from the designated facility boundary or absence from any official assignment outside this boundary.

An escape will be further defined as one of the following levels:

Level I: Escape from non-secure environment such as a community correctional center.

Level II: Escape from a secure perimeter.

Level III: Escape where inmate exhibited serious risk behavior.

A perimeter escape is defined as an escape initiated from inside the perimeter of a correctional facility other than a community release facility.

#### **Summary:**

The number of escapes increased from 87 in FY 1999-00 to 97 in FY 2000-01, but is still down dramatically from past years. Of the 97 escapes in FY 2000-01, 84 (86.6%) were from work release/contract centers. Ninety-two (94.8%) of the 97 escapes were rated as a Level I escape, more commonly referred to as a 'walk-away'. There were no perimeter or Level II types of escapes for FY 2000-01 and only 4 (4.1%) were rated as Level III and exhibited any type of serious risk behavior.

The overall escape rate increased slightly from 1.25 in FY 1999-00 to 1.36 in FY 2000-01. The escape rate for correctional institutions, however, was cut in half this last fiscal year from .15 in FY 1999-00 to .07 in FY 2000-01.

Of the 97 completed escapes, 89 (91.8%) were recaptured to date of this report. Eighty-five (95.5%) of the recaptures were recaptured within the quarter in which the escape occurred and 66 (77.6%) of these recaptures were recaptured within 24 hours of the escape.

There were 8 attempted escapes from Florida's correctional facilities. Seven (87.5%) of the attempts occurred at correctional institutions, while 1 (12.5%) occurred at a work camp/road prison.






### Escapes by Facility Type, by Month (July 2000 - June 2001)
