Inmate Escape Report

(Fiscal Year 2004-05)

This report provides information for the fourth quarter (April 2005 - June 2005) of FY 2004-05 in reference to attempted escapes, escapes and recaptures from Florida's correctional facilities. This report summarizes the following:

- * Attempted escapes
- * Escapes by level, facility type, and facility type by region
- * Recaptures and recaptures within quarter, by time to recapture, and time to recapture by facility type
- * Escape rates and rates by region, and facility type by region
- * Escapes by facility type, by month
- * Escape rates by region, by quarter

For purposes of this report attempted escape and escape are defined as follows:

Attempted escape: Inmate is apprehended before completion of the escape act.

Escape: Unauthorized absence from the designated facility boundary or absence from any official assignment outside this boundary.

An escape will be further defined as one of the following levels:

Level I: Escape from non-secure environment, such as a community correctional center or an outside work squad, in which no Level III behaviors are exhibited.

Level II: Escape from a secure perimeter in which no Level III behaviors are exhibited.

Level III: Escape that involves hostages, weapons/tools, outside assistance, or violence during or after the escape.

An escape rate is defined as the number of escapes/(total population on the last day of the month for each month in the quarter/3)* 1,000.

A perimeter escape is defined as one initiated from inside the perimeter of a correctional facility other than a community release facility.

Summary:

The number of escapes increased from 109 in FY 2003-04 to 118 in FY 2004-05. The majority of these escapes were from work release/contract centers (90.7%) and were the least serious type Level 1 escapes (96.6%). There were eight escapes from a correctional institution, four of which were walk-a-ways from a work squad. There were four escapes that breached the secure perimeter of a correctional facility.

The overall escape rate rose from 1.37 in FY 2003-04 to 1.42 in FY 2004-05. The escape rate for correctional institutions rose from 0.04 in FY 2003-04 to 0.11 in FY 2004-05.

Of the 118 completed escapes, 110 (93.2%) were recaptured by July 1, 2005. Of the 110 recaptures, 102 (92.7%) were recaptured within the quarter in which the escape occurred and 63 (61.8%) were recaptured within 24 hours of the escape.

There were seven attempted and foiled escapes from Florida correctional facilities during FY 2004-05 compared to two during FY 2003-04.






Escapes by Facility Type, by Month (July 2004 - June 2005)
