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#### Inmate Escape Report (Fiscal Year 2009-10)

This report provides information for Fiscal Year 2009-10 (July 2009 - June 2010) in reference to attempted escapes, escapes and recaptures from Florida's correctional facilities. This report summarizes the following:

- \* Attempted escapes
- \* Escapes by level, facility type, and facility type by region
- \* Recaptures and recaptures within quarter, by time to recapture, and time to recapture by facility type
- \* Escape rates and rates by region, and facility type by region
- \* Escapes by facility type, by month
- \* Escape rates by region, by quarter

For purposes of this report attempted escape and escape are defined as follows: Attempted escape: Inmate is apprehended before completion of the escape act. Escape: Unauthorized absence from the designated facility boundary or absence from any official assignment outside this boundary.

An escape is further defined as one of the following levels:

Level I: Escape from non-secure environment, such as a community correctional center or an outside work squad, in which no Level III behaviors are exhibited.

Level II: Escape from a secure perimeter in which no Level III behaviors are exhibited.

Level III: Escape that involves hostages, weapons/tools, outside assistance, or violence during or after the escape.

An escape rate is defined as the number of escapes/(total population on the last day of the month for each month in the quarter/3)\* 1,000.

A perimeter escape is defined as one initiated from inside the perimeter of a correctional facility other than a community release facility.

#### Summary:

The number of escapes decreased from 158 in FY 2008-09 to 150 in FY 2009-10. Of the 150 escapes one escape (0.7%) was from a major C.I. while on work detail outside the perimeter. 3 escapes (2.0%) were from a work camp/road prison while on work detail outside the perimeter. 146 of 150 escapes (97.3%) were from work release/contract centers. 147 (98.0%) escapes were Level I escapes with no Level II escapes. There were 2 (1.3%) Level III escapes and 1 (0.7%) undefined escape. There were no escapes in FY 2009-10 that constituted a breach of a secure perimeter.

Of the 150 completed escapes, 144 (96.0%) were recaptured to date of this report. 134 of the 144 recaptured, (93.1%) were recaptured within the same quarter as the escape. 86 (64.2%) of the 134 were recaptured within 24 hours of the escape.

The overall escape rate decreased from 1.61 in FY 2008-09 to 1.51 in FY 2009-10. The escape rate for correctional institutions was 0.01 and the escape rate for work camps/road prison was 0.25. Region I had the lowest overall rate per 1,000 inmates for the fiscal year at 0.19 whereas Region III had the highest at 3.65.

There were 5 attempted and foiled escapes from Florida correctional facilities during Fiscal Year 2009-10.






