

Definition of a Minority-, Woman-, and/or Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business

To become certified as a minority-, woman-, and/or service-disabled veteran-owned business enterprise in Florida¹, a business must be:

- Engaged in commercial transactions
- Domiciled in Florida
- A minimum of fifty-one percent owned, managed, and controlled by an African American, Hispanic American, Asian American, Native American, woman or service-disabled veteran who is a permanent resident of Florida and a United States citizen; and
- A small business that is independently owned and operated, with a net worth of no more than \$5 million and that employs less than 200 full-time permanent employees, or is recognized as a certified business by the federal government

Certification benefits include:

- First-tier referrals to state agencies for order and contract opportunities
- Mentor-Protégé opportunities for business development guidance from established corporations
- Exclusive listing of state-certified minority business enterprises in an online directory
- Participation at regional workshops, seminars, and corporate roundtables and discounts at the annual Florida MatchMaker Conference & Trade Show
- Workshops to help grow business
- Loan mobilization to assist eligible businesses with funding

Agency Compliance

Section 287.09451 (4) (0) 2, Florida Statutes annually requires all state agencies and universities to submit Business Utilization Plans to the Office of Supplier Diversity. Each plan must include the organization's strategy for ensuring diversity in the organization's purchasing and contracting opportunities, as well as the previous fiscal year's spending with minority-, women-, and service-disabled veteran-owned business enterprises. Plans must also include a statement and assessment of good faith efforts taken by each state agency and a status report of agency compliance with subsection (6), as determined by the Minority Business Enterprise Office.



Businesses Certified During Fiscal Year 2011-12

During Fiscal Year 2011-12, the Office of Supplier Diversity (OSD) certified 517 new minority-, woman-, and service-disabled veteran-owned business enterprises statewide representing a 23.52 percent decrease over Fiscal Year 2010-11. Of these businesses:

- 245 were Caucasian woman-owned business enterprises
- 119 were Hispanic American-owned business enterprises
- 81 were African American-owned business enterprises
- 32 were Asian American-owned business enterprises
- 37 were Service-Disabled Veteran-owned business enterprises (SDVBE)
- 3 were Native American-owned business enterprises



Total Fiscal Year 2011-12 Minority Businesses

During Fiscal Year 2011-12 there were a total of 4,562 certified minority-, woman-, and service-disabled veter¬an-owned business enterprises statewide. This represents a 16.66 percent decrease over Fiscal Year 2010-11 of 5,474 minority businesses statewide. Of the certified businesses:

- 2,030 were Caucasian woman-owned business enterprises
- 1,184 were Hispanic American-owned business enterprises
- 901 were African American-owned business enterprises
- 263 were Asian American-owned business enterprises
- 139 were Service-Disabled Veteran-owned business enterprises (SDVBE)
- 45 were Native American-owned business enterprises



Fiscal Year 2011-12 Total Agency Expenditures By Industry

In Fiscal Year 2011-12, the total state government expenditures for commodities, construction, contractual services and architects and engineers surpassed \$72.0 billion. Of these amounts:

- 82 percent were for commodities purchases
- 9 percent were construction related purchases
- 8 percent were contract related services, and
- 1 percent was architect and engineering related services
