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## Inmate Escape Report (Fiscal Year 2015-16)

This report provides information for FY 2015-16 in reference to attempted escapes, escapes and recaptures from Florida's correctional facilities. This report summarizes the following:

- Attempted escapes;
- Escapes by level, facility type, and facility type by region;
- Recaptures, recaptures within quarter, by time to recapture, and time to recapture by facility type;
- Escape rates and rates by region, and facility type by region;
- Escapes by facility type, by month; and
- Escape rates by region, by quarter.

For purposes of this report, attempted escape and escape are defined as follows:

- Attempted escape: Inmate is apprehended before completion of the escape act.
- **Escape:** Unauthorized absence from the designated facility boundary or absence from any official assignment outside this boundary.

An escape is further defined as one of the following levels:

- Level I: Escape from non-secure environment, such as a community correctional center or an outside work squad, in which no Level III behaviors are exhibited.
- Level II: Escape from a secure perimeter or supervised environment in which no Level III behaviors are exhibited.
- Level III: Escape that involves hostages, weapons/tools, outside assistance, or violence during or after the escape.

An **escape rate** is defined as the number of escapes/(total population on the last day of the month for each month in the quarter/3)\* 1,000.

A **perimeter escape** is defined as one initiated from inside the perimeter of a correctional facility other than a community release facility.

#### **Summary:**

The number of escapes decreased 39.7% from 73 in FY 2014-15 to 44 in FY 2015-16. One (2.3%) of the 44 escapes was from a Correctional Institution (C.I.). It was a Level I escape. Three (6.8%) were from a work camp/road prison; all 3 were Level I escapes. Forty (90.9%) were from work release/contract centers; of those, thirty-eight were Level I escapes, and two were not rated.

Of the 44 escapes, 42 (95.5%) were Level I escapes, and 2 (4.5%) were designated as "not rated." There were no Level II or Level III escapes in FY 2015-16.

Of the 44 escapes, 42 (95.5%) were recaptured as of August 6, 2016. Of the 42 recaptured, 35 (83.3%) were recaptured within the quarter. Of the 35 recaptured within the quarter, 19 (54.3%) were recaptured within 24 hours of the escape.

The overall escape rate for Fiscal Year 2015-16 was 0.45 escapes per 1,000 inmates. This is lower than the 0.74 rate observed for Fiscal Year 2014-15. The escape rate for correctional institutions was 0.01 per 1,000 inmates. The escape rate for work camps/road prisons was 0.26 per 1,000 inmates. The escape rate for work release/community contract centers was 9.71 per 1,000 inmates. Region IV had the highest escape rate at 1.21 per 1,000 inmates. Region I had the lowest rate with 0 escapes during FY 2015-16.

There were 6 attempted escapes in Fiscal Year 2015-16.




