### Inmate Escape Report Fiscal Year 2020-21

This report is provided in accordance with Florida Statute 944.151 (7). The data provides information for Fiscal Year 2020-21 in reference to attempted escapes, escapes and recaptures from Florida's correctional facilities. This report summarizes the following:

- Attempted escapes;
- Escapes by level, facility type, and facility type by region;
- Recaptures, recaptures within quarter, by time to recapture, and time to recapture by facility type;
- Escape rates and rates by region, and facility type by region;
- Escapes by facility type, by month; and
- · Escape rates by region, by quarter.

For purposes of this report, attempted escape and escape are defined as follows:

- Attempted escape: Inmate is apprehended before completion of the escape act.
- **Escape:** Unauthorized absence from the designated facility boundary or absence from any official assignment outside this boundary.

An escape is further defined as one of the following levels:

- Level I: Escape from non-secure environment, such as a community correctional center or an outside work squad, in which no Level III behaviors are exhibited.
- Level II: Escape from a secure perimeter or supervised environment in which no Level III behaviors are exhibited.
- **Level III:** Escape that involves hostages, weapons/tools, outside assistance, or violence during or after the escape.

An **escape rate** is defined as the number of escapes/(total population on the last day of the month for each month in the quarter/3)\* 1,000.

A **perimeter escape** is defined as one initiated from inside the perimeter of a correctional facility other than a community release facility.

#### **Summary:**

The number of escapes decreased by 23.3% from 30 in FY 2019-20 to 23 in FY 2020-21. One (4.3%) of the 23 escapes was from a Correctional Institution (C.I.). The escape from a Correctional Institution was not from a secure perimeter, but from an outside work squad. Due to the use of a shovel as a weapon to assault the work squad officer and the theft of a DOT vehicle, the escape was deemed a Level III escape. Two (8.7%) of the 23 escapes were from a Work Camp/Road Prison; one was a Level II escape, and one was a Level III escape. The Level III escape from a Work Camp/Road Prison was deemed Level III due to possible outside assistance. The remaining 20 (87.0%) escapes were from Work Release/Contract Centers and all of the 20 were Level I escapes.

Of the 23 escapes, 18 (78.3%) were recaptured as of July 7, 2021. Of the 18 recaptured, 17 (94.4%) were recaptured within the same quarter the escape occurred. Of the 17 recaptured within the quarter, 9 (52.9%) were recaptured within 24 hours of the escape.

The overall escape rate for Fiscal Year 2020-21 was 0.29 escapes per 1,000 inmates. This is lower than the 0.33 rate observed for Fiscal Year 2019-20 as well as the 0.36 rate observed for Fiscal Year 2018-19. The escape rate for Correctional Institutions was 0.01 per 1,000 inmates and the escape rate for Work Camps/Road Prisons was 0.29 per 1,000 inmates. Work Release/Contract Centers had the highest escape rates for Fiscal Year 2020-21 at 7.74 per 1,000 inmates. Region III had the highest escape rate at 0.77 per 1,000 inmates and Region I had the lowest rate at 0.12.

There were 3 attempted escapes in Fiscal Year 2020-21.




