^{*} Ch. 2020-89, amended the protections for incarcerated pregnant women, which now extend to the use of "restrictive housing" for delinquent girls during their known or confirmed pregnancies. The Departments of Corrections and Juvenile Justice are required to adopt implementing rules. For DJJ, this will require minor amendments to rule chapter 63G-2.022 governing secure detention and 63E-7.107 governing residential facilities.
