Dear Governor Scott:

Per Florida Law, the Department of Children and Families is responsible to report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability the status of any Citizen Support or Direct-support organizations that is administered by the agency. Furthermore, the statute requires the Department to report, by August 15 of each year, statutorily-prescribed information, per F.S. 20.058, from any Citizen Support or Direct-support Organization that is received and would be maintained via the agency website. The report must also include a recommendation by our agency on whether to continue, terminate or modify the agency's association with each organization.

In order to comply with this statute, I would like to state that the Department of Children and Families does not currently administer a Citizen Support or Direct-support Organization.
