Per Florida Law, the Department of Children and Families is responsible to report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability the status of any Citizen Support or Direct-support Organizations that are administered by the agency. Furthermore, the statute requires the department to report, by August 15 of each year, statutorily-prescribed information, per F.S. 20.058, any proceeds received from any Citizen Support or Direct-support Organization maintained via the agency website. The report must also include a recommendation by our agency on whether to continue, terminate, or modify the agency's association with each organization.

In order to comply with this statute, please note that the Department of Children and Families does not currently administer a Citizen Support or Direct-support Organization.
