FLORIDA COMMISSION ON OFFENDER REVIEW 2020 - 2021 ANNUAL REGULATORY PLAN

PART 1.

This part fulfills the requirements of section 120.74(1)(a), Florida Statutes, according to which the Commission must provide a list of laws that meet certain criteria, including a listing of each law enacted or amended during the previous twelve months which creates or modifies the duties or authority of the agency, except those laws that affect all or most agencies.

No Commission specific legislation was enacted or implemented in the 2020 Regular Session that created or modified the duties or authority of the Commission.
